Numeracy and Maths

We are learning to:

- read, write and order numbers to 1000
- partition 2 and 3 digit numbers into TOs or HTOs
- use fact families to link addition and subtraction facts
- practise our 2 and 10 times tables



Topic/IDL

This term we will be exploring United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child through picture book stories.

We will also be discussing internet safety and ways to stay safe online.

We are also taking part in Fun3I sessions, completing a range of different activities in mixed groups of P1-3.



Literacy

We are learning to:

- revise tricky phonemes
- use adjectives in our writing to make it more interesting
- continue to read over our writing to make sure it makes sense
- talk clearly about the main idea in our book and retell the story
