Numeracy and Maths

We are continuing to:

- Recognise count and write numbers to 100 and beyond.
- Problem solve to complete number Fact Families with missing numbers.
- Partition numbers up to 100. Identify the value of each digit in a number (52 is 5 tens and 2 ones.)
- Estimate the height and weight of everyday objects.
- Explore and identify which 2D shapes objects and patterns are symmetrical.

Literacy

We are continuing to:

- Consolidate our knowledge of all letter sounds and digraphs.
- Read and write known words independently and use a dictionary to aid our spelling of tricky words.
- Read and write common words and high frequency words.
- Write our news and imaginative stories using nouns, proper nouns, adjectives, and connectives.
- Develop our confidence in talking and listening by sharing information about a favourite toy/object and answering questions from others..

Health and Wellbeing

We will be focusing on friendships, likes and dislikes and looking after each other. We will also think about who we can talk to if we are worried or upset.

PE
