Numeracy and Maths

We are continuing to:

- Recognise count and write numbers to 100 and beyond.
- Use the column method to solve add and subtract sums.
- Estimate and measure the area of shapes using cubes.
- Use shapes to tile patterns.
- Identify lines of symmetry.
- Use tally marks to record information.
- Display and sort information using block graphs and Venn Diagrams.

Literacy

We are continuing to:

- Write stories using different sentence openers.
- Use commas to make lists.
- Write questions and punctuate using question marks.
- Use imperative verbs to write instructions.
- Extend our writing pieces by adding more detail.
- Read and write known words independently and use a dictionary to aid our spelling of tricky words.
- Develop our confidence in talking and listening by giving a solo talk.

Health and Wellbeing

Our focus this term is looking after our bodies and how we change as we grow. We will discuss what to do in unsafe situations, emergencies and who can help. We will be sharing what we have enjoyed and learned in P2. Looking at our next steps, sharing feelings and questions as we move to P3.

This term, we will be focussing on athletics, developing our team work, and practising events for Sports Day.
